Re:	2024 Field Support

Casino Mining Corporation (Casino) will be conducting a comprehensive field program at the Casino Project Site during the summer of 2024. This memo outlines information about the field work opportunities, info about travel, room, and board as well as the type of work that will be conducted, and the skills needed to support this work.

These field work opportunities are being provided to you as training and experience opportunities. An honorarium of \$400 per day will be provided.

While working on our field program, all reasonable costs for travel, room, and board will be provided by Casino. Expenses will be related to where Casino mobilizes from and your point of origin. Please note, some approved travel costs may need to be paid for upfront and will be reimbursed once approved.

Access to site will be by air (flights coordinated by Casino) and there is an on-site camp with a kitchen as well as sleeping and washroom facilities. For stays at camp, you are responsible for bringing your own sleeping bag, pillow, towel, water bottle, toiletries, and other personal items. Please also bring your own work gear and PPE, including appropriate clothing per task, sturdy work boots, safety glass, and gloves. If you do not have access to the above-mentioned work gear or safety gear, please contact Melanie Dallow (mdallow@casinomining.com) as arrangements may be made to access gear on site.

You do not need to commit to the entire suite of programs, only those that are of interest to you. If you would like to participate, please contact Melanie Dallow (mdallow@casinomining.com).

Please note that all dates provided are subject to change. If dates are changed, sufficient notice will be provided to all participants.

Monthly Water Quality and Hydrology Sampling:

- DATES: May 13 to June 5, July 15 to 19, August 5 to 9, September 9 to 13, October 7 to 11, November TBD, December TBD.
- TASKS: Working in and around streams/creeks/rivers. Help crew collect water quality samples and streamflow data.
- REQUIREMENTS: Need to be comfortable flying in a helicopter to sample locations. Physically fit to hike/walk in variable ground conditions (in waders) to sampling locations. Would require non-leak chest waders, non-slip footwear, and wading belt.

Fish Array Installation and Pit Tagging:

- DATES: May 27 to May 30.
- TASKS: Assist crews with installing three fish array systems, tagging fish and monitoring locations.
- REQUIREMENTS: Working in and around streams/creeks/rivers. Need to be comfortable flying in a helicopter to sample locations. Physically fit to hike/walk in variable ground conditions (in waders) to sampling locations. Would require non-leak chest waders, non-slip footwear, polarized sunglasses, and wading belt.

Fish Bearing Status Verification:

- DATES: June 17 to June 20 and September 23 to September 26.
- TASKS: Help crew conduct fish habitat assessments and collect fish samples (via electrofishing and minnow trapping) to verify fish presence.
- REQUIREMENTS: Working in and around streams/creeks/rivers. Need to be comfortable flying in a helicopter to sample locations. Physically fit to hike/walk in variable ground conditions (in waders) to sampling locations. Would require non-leak chest waders, non-slip footwear, polarized sunglasses, and wading belt.

Fish Spawning Survey and Habitat Assessment:

- DATES: July 29 to August 3.
- TASKS: Completing aerial and ground spawning surveys via helicopter, assist crews to conduct fish and fish habitat assessments and fish sampling (via electrofishing and minnow trapping).
- REQUIREMENTS: Working in and around streams/creeks/rivers. Need to be comfortable flying in a helicopter to sample locations. Physically fit to hike/walk in variable ground conditions (in waders) to sampling locations. Would require non-leak chest waders, non-slip footwear, polarized sunglasses, and wading belt.

Wildlife Field Verification Surveys:

- DATES: July 15 to July 22.
- TASKS: Assist crew with wildlife verification surveys, through wildlife and vegetation observations.
- REQUIREMENTS: Need to be comfortable flying in a helicopter. Physically fit to hike/walk in variable ground conditions for an 8 to 10-hour shift.

Vegetation Mapping and Surveys:

- DATES: July 22 to July 29.
- TASKS: Assist crew in assessing a diversity of vegetation communities within each bioclimate zone throughout the Freegold road area.
- REQUIREMENTS: Access will be via truck. Physically fit to hike/walk in variable ground conditions for an 8 to 10-hour shift.

Seed Collection:

- DATES: August 12 to August 16.

- **TASKS:** Helping collect, process and store native seeds present at the Casino site.
- **REQUIREMENTS:** Need to be comfortable flying in a helicopter. Experience using UTVs. Physically fit to hike/walk in variable ground conditions.
