

CAREER PROFILE: CAMP MAINTENANCE



Camp Maintenance Personnel are responsible for ensuring the cleanliness of camp facilities and mining camps. They perform a wide range of duties including:

- Keeping camp facilities clean
- Maintaining cleaning supplies
- Maintaining and upkeeping equipment
- Performing routine maintenance activities
- Notifying management of the need for repairs
- Clearing snow or debris

These types of positions usually require shift work. That means two weeks at site followed by two weeks off. Depending on the needs of the camp, personnel may work longer days (e.g. twelve-hour day).

- Good hand-eye coordination
- Good organizational skills
- Attention to detail
- Ability to multitask and prioritize tasks
