## Casino Mining Donates to Child Development Centre Sensory Room

**Whitehorse, Yukon** – Casino Mining Corporation (Casino), through its *Casino Cares* sponsorship program, is pleased to announce a donation of \$25,000 to the Child Development Centre (CDC) to purchase equipment, materials and tools for the organization’s Sensory Room.

In August 2023, the CDC moved into its new location at 206 Hanson Street in Whitehorse and one of the new rooms is a Sensory Room, which with Casino’s support, can be adequately outfitted and used to its full potential to help Yukon children reach their sensory therapeutic goals.

“We are proud to provide this support to the CDC to help local children with sensory processing needs,” says Sandeep Singh, Casino Chief Executive Officer (CEO). “Whenever you have the ability and the opportunity to help children meet their full potential, it is a privilege to do so.”

In 2023, Casino also donated \$25,000 to the CDC to support the purchase of equipment for the organization’s therapeutic pre-school outdoor playground, which officially opened last September, for a total donation of \$50,000 to date.

“We are grateful for this generous donation from Casino Mining,” says Alayne Squair, CDC’s Executive Director. “How a child processes sensory information impacts how they can regulate their emotions, pay attention, connect with others and feel ready for learning. This funding will enable us to purchase equipment and resources to ensure the room is a safe space where children can work towards achieving their therapeutic goals.”

“Working with the CDC team to achieve mutual goals for our territory’s children and their families is uplifting and very rewarding,” says Shena Shaw, Casino VP, Environmental and Community Affairs. “I’m the mother of three children and my daughters accessed the services and supports of the CDC, so supporting the developmental needs of all Yukon children the CDC serves is important to me personally and to the entire Casino team.”



The Child Development Centre, a not-for-profit organization was established in 1979 and serves over 1100 children a year in Whitehorse and all Yukon communities.
