Responsibilities

- Supporting, and at times leading, the development, maintenance, and implementation of agreements with First Nations.
- Refining and implementing Casino's Consultation and Engagement Strategy and First Nation Engagement plans.
- Identifying and tracking concerns and interests identified by First Nations and communities impacted by our project.
- Leading communications and building relationships with First Nations and communities impacted by the Casino Project as well as other community stakeholders.
- Developing and leading community awareness campaigns.
- Supporting the Casino Cares Sponsorship Program.
- Identifying and facilitating economic development and social impact initiatives and opportunities with First Nations and communities impacted by the Casino Project.

- Developing communications related content, such as newsletters, presentations, and engagement materials, in collaboration with our consulting team.
- Preparing and managing events related to engagement activities, such as open houses, workshops and meetings, including logistical arrangements, developing agendas, and writing reports.
- Leading Corporate Social Responsibility initiatives and activities.
- Promoting cultural awareness within Casino Mining Corp and our consultants.
- Developing and implementing Environment Social Governance (“ESG”) metric tracking.
- Performing other duties associated with this position may be required.
