

## THE PROJECT

Casino Mining Corporation (Casino) is a responsible critical minerals development company with an experienced and committed team, most of whom live in the Yukon, devoted to advancing the proposed Casino Project; a copper-gold, molybdenum and silver deposit located approximately 300km northwest of Whitehorse.

The region's geology ranks the proposed Project among the largest economically viable copper-gold deposits in the world and once in production would be Canada's largest producer of critical minerals.



The mostly Whitehorse-based Casino team is committed to respectful, collaborative relationships and open and transparent communication with governments, individuals, local businesses and communities to help the proposed Project advance and provide social and economic benefits to Yukoners and Canadians for generations to come.

Currently preparing to re-enter the Yukon's environmental assessment process, Casino is proposing a conventional open-pit, truck and shovel operation over an approximate 27-year mine life following a four-year construction period.

Casino is firmly committed to the health, safety and well-being of all Yukoners, to the preservation of their social, cultural and environmental values and to contributing to Canada's transition to a green economy throughout the life of the proposed Project.

## **ADVANCING THE PROJECT**




Exploration began in the Casino Project area in the early 20th Century with the first mineral claim dating back to 1917. In 2006, Western Copper and Gold Corporation acquired the Casino Project site and established Casino Mining Corporation, which wholly-owns the property.

Casino is working on its submission

of the Project's Environmental and Socio-economic Statement (ESE) to the Yukon Environmental and Socio-economic Assessment Board (YESAB).

The ESE Statement is an important step in the YESAB Panel Review process; the highest level of project assessment in the Yukon and the first to be conducted in the territory.

As Casino prepares the ESE Statement, the team continues to conduct comprehensive environmental monitoring programs and studies at site and with surrounding communities.
